- Complete 45 hours with a 2.7 GPA (2.7 GPA must be maintained)
- Complete the Praxis Core
- Be proficient in Reading and English
- Pass the background check

Second Academic Concentration (SAC)

- Required of all Elementary Education majors
- 18 hours each
- If completing the AA in Teacher Prep, it is recommended that students complete either the Diversity Studies or Social Studies SAC to complete the degree in the time laid out in this plan.
- <u>The SAC DOES NOT have to be completed before transferring to Appalachian but should be selected as early as possible</u>. Students will work with an Appalachian advisor, after transferring, to develop an individual graduation plan.
