- Applying to Appalachian:

  A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.25, from all post-secondary coursework, is required for admission to Appalachian.
- Students interested in applying to Appalachian should submit an on-line application and official college transcripts to be considered for admission.

  Students hoping to attend a summer or fall term are encouraged to apply by February 15th and those hoping to attend in the spring are encouraged to apply by October 15th.

**General Education Completion:** Students following this transfer guide can expect to transfer to Appalachian with their general education requirements met. - Students majoring in Studio Art will be required to complete a portfolio review. All declared BFA majors must pass the portfolio review before enrolling in any 3000 level course within the major.
- Portfolio Content: 10 images of the applicant's best work; a 500 word essay; and appropriate documentation
