1 out of 4

App State undergraduate students have transferred from another institution

**5,036 enrolled undergraduates began as a transfer student*



7 out of 10 new transfer students come from community colleges, 25% from a four-year institution

62% of new Boone campus transfers live off campus

84% of new transfer students were retained for their second year (or graduated)

22% of new transfer students represent diverse populations

3.16 Average GPA of transfer students' previous coursework

52% of new transfer students are first-generation students

29% have already met their General Education requirements

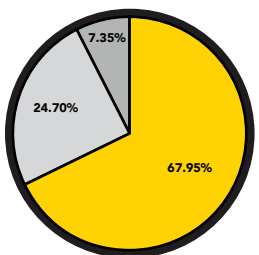
