- Students wishing to complete an emphasis area in a specific studio must take at least 18 hours and no more than 24 hours in that studio area.
- At least 3 hours must come from: ART 3013, 3112, 3140, 3520, 3521, 3522, 3900, 4012, OR 4900

BFA Degree Information:

- A minor is required for this major.
- Students majoring in Studio Art will be required to complete a portfolio review. All declared BFA majors must pass the portfolio review before enrolling in any 3000 level course within the major.
- Portfolio Content: 10 images of the applicant's best work; a 500 word essay; and appropriate documentation of art.
