HOW-TO Use the Transfer Guide/BDP

The Transfer Guides/BDPs have three sections:

- The NC Community College courses are listed in the top yellow section. Recommended and/or preferred courses are provided, with the equivalent Appalachian courses listed. If a specific course is not listed, students should use the blue hyperlink to access the <u>Comprehensive Articulation Agreement transfer course list</u>. Students are welcome to choose any CAA course; however, students should choose courses that are available at their institution and satisfy their transfer degree requirements.
- 2. Appalachian courses are listed in the middle gray section. Once at Appalachian, students will work with an advisor to develop an individual graduation plan.
- 3. Important transfer and major information is listed in the bottom white sections. Students should refer to these sections for information regarding program requirements and other important information the department would like students to be aware of.

Please note - Transfer Guides/BDPs are developed based on the approved curriculum for that catalog year. Depending on term of entry and the curriculum posted for that catalog year, programs of study may have changed.

• A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.25, from all post-secondary coursework, is required for admission to Appalachian.

• Students interested in applying to Appalachian should submit an on-line application and official college transcripts to be considered for admission.

• Students hoping to attend a summer or fall term are encouraged to apply by February 15th and those hoping to attend in the spring are encouraged to apply by October 15th.

Transfer Information:

• The Beaver College of Health Sciences encourages students to work to complete an AA degree prior to transferring. If the AA degree is completed, students can estimate 2 years at Appalachian to complete the BSW degree.

Major Information:

- Overall GPA and Major GPA of 2.5 are required for admission to the Professional Sequence and graduation.
- Transfer students, with a completed AA degree, should expect to take the five foundation courses, as listed above, their first semester at Appalachian.
- Students must earn at least a C in all SW and SW cognate classes. Students can repeat only 2 SW classes.
- Social Work field instruction requires students to complete 32 hours per week of field work (440 hours) and attend Senior . Seminar, which is held each Friday morning and afternoon. No other coursework is allowed during the final semester.
