

TRANSFER STUDENTS by the NUMBERS

1 out of 4 of all undergraduate students at Appalachian have transferred from other institutions



7 out of 10 new transfer students come from community colleges, 27% from a four-year institution

78%	of new main campus transfers live off campus or took classes from home (Covid-19)	85%	of new main campus transfer students were retained for their second year (or graduated)
19%	of new transfer students represent diverse populations	3.25	Average GPA of transfer students' previous coursework
51%	of new transfer students are first-generation students	29%	have already met their General Education requirements
