**Applying to Appalachian:**

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.25, from all post-secondary coursework, is required for admission to Appalachian.
- Students interested in applying to Appalachian should submit an on-line application and official college transcripts to be considered for admission.
- Students hoping to attend a summer or fall term are encouraged to apply by February 15th and those hoping to attend in the spring are encouraged to apply by October 15th.

**Important Information:**

- Music Industry Studies and Music Therapy have additional audition requirements.
- All students should refer to the prospective student tab on the Hayes School of Music website for more information about the audition process.
- Individual degree plans will be developed for each student majoring in a music degree.
- Transfer student should pursue opportunities that will allow them to continue their practice, so to ensure preparedness for required audition and corresponding coursework.
