- Required minor in Non-Profit Management.
- No more than 46 hours in ART may be counted towards the degree (courses used for General Education credit, including ART 2030, ART 2130, and ART 2022, do not count toward the 46 hour limit).
- Students are encouraged to take the introductory courses as well as the two art history surveys early in their program.
- ART 4900 Internship (6) to be completed after junior or senior year (CAP) during consecutive summer sessions 1 & 2 summer
- One 3000 or 4000 level art history class must be focused on Non-Western art.
- One 3000 or 4000 level art history class must be designated WID.

**Residency Requirements:**

- 31 hours must be from ASU
- 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
- 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
- Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)
