 - o This plan is predicated on the assumption that entering freshmen who propose to major in Languages, Literatures, and Cultures with a concentration in Spanish have some language skill.
 - For students who place above SNH 1010, 1020, 1040 or 1050, those courses in the Four Year Guide should be replaced with Free Electives.
 - Due to the various levels at which students enter the language major, significant adjustments to the 4-year plan may be necessary.

- Foreign language classes can be taken in summer semesters.
- Residency Requirements:
 - o 31 hours overall must be from ASU
 - $\circ~~$ 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
 - o 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
 - o Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)
