 - completion of prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of B or 3.0 (transfer equivalency will be accepted, including AP or University Placement)
 - a signed "Professional Dispositions, Behaviors and Essential Functions" agreement form.
 - Prerequisite courses include: CSD 2259 Introduction to Communication Disorders, CSD 2260 Anatomy and Physiology of the Speech and Hearing Mechanism and three semester hours of the general education science inquiry perspective requirement.
- Residency Requirements:**
- o 31 hours overall must be from ASU
 - o 18 hours in the major and 9 hours in minor must be from ASU
 - o 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
 - o Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)
