 - Complete 45 hours with a 2.7 GPA (2.5 GPA must be maintained)
 - Complete the Praxis Core
 - Be proficient in Reading and English
- Residency Requirements:**
- 31 hours must be from Appalachian
 - 18 hours in the major must be from Appalachian
 - 9 hours in the minor must be from Appalachian
 - 50 hours must be from a four-year institution
