Applying to Appalachian:

- A minimum cumulative GPA, from all post-secondary coursework, is required for admission to Appalachian.
- Students interested in applying to Appalachian should submit an on-line application and official college transcripts to be considered for admission.
- Students hoping to attend a summer or fall term are encouraged to apply by February 15th and those hoping to attend in the spring are encouraged to apply by October 15th.
- **Students transferring into the Interior Design major should apply for the first summer session and plan to take two classes each session, as shown above.**

Advising & Community College Course Selection:

- Students should work with their community college academic advisor to ensure appropriate course selection for AA degree completion.

Transfer Information:

- **It is strongly encouraged that students make early contact with Alex Poorman, Program Coordinator, to discuss transfer options and degree completion: poormanaj@appstate.edu.**
- Students who complete an AA degree at a NC community college, will not be required to complete Appalachian's general education requirements. Completing the AA degree will result in students taking courses that will not benefit them in the major and extend time to graduation.
- Students transferring after completion of 30 hours of UGETC coursework will be required to complete Appalachian's general education requirements.
- Students should expect a minimum of three years and two summers to complete the degree at Appalachian.
- To be considered for transfer credit for any INT course a portfolio of all work must be submitted and received prior to
