• The Global Issues requirement is automatically met in this major.

• Restrictions on 3000/4000 level business courses: Business majors can enroll in no more than five 3000/4000 level business courses prior to admission to the College of Business. Students must have 57 hours to take 3000 level business core courses, 60 hours to take all other 3000/4000 level business courses and 90 hours to take 4000 level business courses. A minimum grade of C in ENG 3100 or BE 3340 is required prior to taking any 4000 level business course.
