Notes:

CIS 110: Students must pass the Basic Computer Skills Proficiency Test. Completing CIS 110, with a grade of C or better, will satisfy this requirement.
Foreign Language: The foreign language should be selected early.

- Students must either pursue a language for which ASU offers a minor or another language approved by the IB program coordinator and the foreign language advisor.
- Students who do not place out of any level of foreign language should begin the foreign language prerequisites (1010, 1020, 1040, 1050) in the first semester. The foreign language placement test is available online through the Department of Language, Literature and Culture.
- Students who are not prepared to begin the courses for the language minor/concentration must take up to 12 sh of beginning and intermediate language courses.

Residency Requirements:

- 32 hours must be from Appalachian
- 9 hours in the minor must be from Appalachian
- 50% of business courses in the major must be from Appalachian
- 50 hours must be completed at a 4 year institution

A minimum of a 2.5 GPA is required for admission to the College of Business, based on a minimum of 12 hours completed at Appalachian.

Notes:

- Junior and senior years will vary greatly depending on study abroad program selected. Planning for these terms should be done individually with the international business advisor.
- Students should begin talking with the international business advisor about their study abroad requirement prior to the junior year.
- The Global Issues requirement is automatically met in this major.
- Restrictions on 3000/4000 level business courses:** Business majors can enroll in no more than five 3000/4000 level business courses prior to admission to the College of Business. Students must have 57 hours to take 3000 level business core courses, 60 hours to take all other 3000/4000 level business courses and 90 hours to take 4000 level business courses. A minimum grade of C in ENG 3100 or BE 3340 is required prior to taking any 4000 level business course.
