- Students who do not place out of any level of foreign language should begin the foreign language prerequisites (1010, 1020, 1040, 1050) in the first semester. The foreign language placement test is available online through the Department of Language, Literature and Culture.
- Students who are not prepared to begin the courses for the language minor/concentration must take up to 12 sh of beginning and intermediate language courses. Students must pass the Basic Computer Skills Proficiency test or CIS 1026 (CIS 110). If needed, it is recommended that students take the test their first semester so CIS 1026 can be taken if the test is not passed.

- Students should begin talking with the international business avisor about their study abroad requirement prior to the junior year.
- The Global Issues requirement is automatically met in this major.
- International Business majors must earn a minimum GPA of 2.0 in the18 hours International Business major courses and major/approved electives.

Restrictions on 3000/4000 level business courses: Business majors can enroll in no more than five 3000/4000 level business courses prior to admission to the College of Business. Students must have 54 hours to take 3000 level business courses, and 84hours to take 4000 level business courses. A minimum grade of C in ENG 3100 or BE 3340 is required prior to taking any 4000 level business course.
