**Application**

- Acceptance to ASU as a pre-nursing major still requires a separate application for admission into the nursing program
- Application deadline: January 15<sup>th</sup>
- Essay component is required in application
- 45 students accepted each spring – start BSN classes the following summer
- It is encouraged that students submit SAT & ACT scores, if taken

**GPA**

- 3.00:** minimum to apply – previous college GPA included in calculation (Early College and CCP, also)
- 3.5-4.0** - GPA range accepted for 2016 cohort
- A grade of C or above is required for each non-science prerequisite course.
- A grade of B- or higher is required for all science coursework.
- An overall GPA of 2.5 is required in Nursing courses at the end of the junior year and every semester after.

**Residency Requirements:**

- 31 hours must be from ASU
- 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
- 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
- Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)
