- · It is encouraged that students submit SAT & ACT scores, if taken

GPA

- 3.00: minimum to apply previous college GPA included in calculation (Early College and CCP, also)
- 3.5-4.0 GPA range accepted for 2016 cohort
- A grade of C or above is required for each non-science prerequisiste course.
- A grade of B- or higher is required for all science coursework.
- An overall GPA of 2.5 is required in Nursing courses at the end of the junior year and every semester after.

- Residency Requirements: 31 hours must be from ASU 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
- 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
- Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)
