Notes:

- Social work majors must earn a C or better in all required cognate and pre-requisite courses. Social work majors must complete the foundation courses (SW 2010, SW 2020, SW 2615, SW 2630, and SW 3000) with a C or better and be accepted into the Professional Sequence in order to move on to Professional Sequence courses (SW 3330, SW 3850, SW 3870, SW 4000, SW 4010, SW 4020, SW 4650, SW 4690, SW electives). Social work majors must complete the Professional Sequence courses with a C or better to move onto Field. Social work majors must complete Field Seminar with a C or better and receive a "Satisfactory" grade in Field Placement in order to graduate. - Transfer students should plan to complete their Foundation courses during their first semester at Appalachian.
- The website (<http://socialwork.appstate.edu/undergraduate>) has advising tips and information about what to expect as a BSW major.
- Students should consult the Program of Study when planning elective coursework, as many are semester specific.
- Social Work Field Instruction requires students to complete 32 hours of field work each week and attend Senior Seminar, which is held Friday mornings. It is not recommended that students take any other courses during their final semester.

Residency Requirements:

- 31 hours must be from ASU
- 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
- 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
- Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)
