- Meet Praxis I/SAT/ACT requirements
- Must have a 2.7 GPA before being admitted to the Reich College of Education. You will need to apply for admission to the Reich College of Education after meeting Praxis I/SAT/ACT requirements, completion of CI 2300 and FDN 2400 and 45 hours of coursework. Check your SAT/ACT scores to determine if you need to take Praxis I prior to admission to the RCOE. A minimum grade of "C" is required in each professional education course.
- Begin the Second Academic Concentration (SAC) in CIS as soon as possible to avoid sequencing problems and ensure timely completion.

- **Residency Requirements:**
 - o 31 hours must be from ASU
 - o 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
 - o 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
 - o Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)

- MKT 120, Principals of Marketing, can be taken to satisfy MKT 3050 requirement. MKT 120 is NOT a CAA approved courses and students should consult their community college to see if it can be included in degree requirements.
- 9 hours of computer classes (except CIS 110, 111 & OST 137) can be taken at the community college to fulfill the Second Academic Concentration (SAC) requirement.
