- Residency Requirements:**
- o 31 hours must be from ASU
  - o 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
  - o 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
  - o Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)

- Second Academic Concentration: Consult with Program Director. Most courses will be waived based on the degree earned at the community college.
- Skills Area Courses: Equivalent of 15 hours in a specific area; must be approved by Program Director.
