- A contract with a list of the approved Career-Oriented Concentration Area courses MUST be filed with the College of Arts & Sciences Dean's Office no later than the end of the first semester of junior year.
 - At least 3 hours of 2000-level HIS is required prior to taking a 3000-level HIS course; at least 3 hours of 3000-level HIS courses is required prior to taking a 4000-level HIS course.
 - No more than 15 hours (including HIS 2800) from the 2000 level may be used to fulfill Area III requirements.
 - Mixing History and other requirements early in the program is recommended in order to avoid having to take more than 3 History courses at the same time late in the program.
- Residency Requirements:
- o 31 hours must be from ASU
 - o 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
 - o 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
 - o Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)
