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- ansfer Information: The Beaver College of Health Sciences DOES NOT encourage students to complete an AA degree when pursuing a degree in Nutrition. It is highly recommended that student complete 30 UGETC hours and then transfer to Appalachian. If an AA degree is completed, students can expect another 3 years to complete their BS degree. Students planning to become a Registered Dietitian should complete all requirements, as outlined on the Nutrition and Foods website, found here
- Students will also have to become licensed in the state of North Carolina, if planning to work in the state.
