

Spring 2019 Numbers

78% of Spring 2019 new Appalachian students are transfers

(573 total new students = 285 true transfers, 163 first-year transfers, 125 true first-years)

- 50% of Spring 2019 new Appalachian students are true transfer students (have been out of high school for more than one year and taken college coursework after high school graduation)
- 28% of Spring 2019 new Appalachian students are first-year (“green”) transfer students (graduated from high school in May 2018 and attended another college for Fall 2018)
- 30 new Veterans and 4 new early college students began in Spring 2019
